WINEMAKER Ian Scarborough, Jerome Scarborough **EST.** 1985 **CASES** 15 000

Ian Scarborough honed his white winemaking skills during his years as a consultant, and has brought all those skills to his own label. He makes 3 different styles of Chardonnay: the Blue Label in a light, elegant, Chablis style for the export market and a richer barrel-fermented wine (Yellow Label) primarily directed to the Australian market, the third is the White Label, a cellar door-only wine made in the best vintages. However, the real excitement for the future lies with the portion of the old Lindemans Sunshine Vineyard which he has purchased (after it lay fallow for 30 years) and planted with semillon and (quixotically) pinot noir. The first vintage from the legendary Sunshine Vineyard was made in 2004; in the meantime, Ian has kept his hand in with contract-grown semillon. Exports to the UK and the US.

🍷🍷🍷 **Semillon 2005** Bright green-straw; a fuller style of semillon, the alcohol determining the outcome; plenty of fruit on entry, but does tail off slightly on the finish. Screwcap. 12° alc. **RATING** 89 **DRINK** 2008 \$ 19

Blue Label Chardonnay 2004 Rich, sweet fig and peach fruit; abundant mouthfeel, the oak incidental. Screwcap. 13.5° alc. **RATING** 89 **DRINK** 2008 \$ 19
